THE SUPERVISORY BOARD'S REMIT

The Supervisory Board is responsible for ensuring that the Norwegian Correctional Service complies with applicable rules and human rights.

The Supervisory Board is responsible for assisting in the safeguarding of inmate welfare.

The Supervisory Board is responsible for regularly visiting the prison.

As an inmate, you can speak to the Supervisory Board about your welfare while you are serving your sentence. Talking to the Supervisory Board is voluntary.

The Supervisory Board cannot annul, reverse or amend the content of a decision or a ruling by a court.

CONTACTING THE SUPERVISORY BOARD

The Correctional Service must ensure that inmates are able to contact the Supervisory Board. You can contact us by phone or e-mail or by writing a letter. Relatives are also free to contact the Supervisory Board.

Telephone calls with the Supervisory Board must be given priority. These calls are free and are not included in call times.

Calls with the Supervisory Board will not be monitored and written communication will not be read.

Writing materials and stamped envelopes are available free of charge.

You can contact the Supervisory Board regarding your welfare in prison or anywhere else in the Correctional Service's institutions. You might for example want to contact them concerning meals, activities that are being offered, outdoor time, isolation, the use of coercion and force, the possibility of communicating with others, the handling of personal possessions, cleaning and hygiene, and/or your relationship with employees.

The Supervisory Board is subject to a duty of secrecy.
